
Reading: Class Text: Our texts for this term are finishing off "Little Red Reading Hood" followed by "In My Heart" and "Fluffy Squishy Itty Bitty.". We will be reading together and sharing the text during our English lessons. We will be developing word reading, comprehension and discussion in groups, and with the teacher. Within our guided reading sessions, we will continue to use our phonic knowledge to decode words and develop fluency. We now use Teach Hub which allows the children to access a whole text, rather than an extract.

Mriting: We will continue looking at 'Little Red Reading Hood' and completing work around this. This will include planning and writing a narrative story. Our texts during this term will include poetry, where we will look at features of poems and how to construct them.

History: Our next topic will be Changes in Technology and how it has evolved over the years. We will look at important inventors and how technology has changed our lives.

Geography: Our next topic is Contrasting Localities. We will look at a village in Zambia and compare it to our local area. We will look at the

features, weather and landscapes in both areas. PRE: Within RE we will be studying What is the good news Jesus brings. We will be looking at the word 'Gospel' Christians believe they have been given



rules on how to live.

Reading: 5 times a week as per home/school agreement. This will be monitored on Fridays and children will be rewarded. Books are changed on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Spellings: Given out weekly, tested on Fridays. Homework: Handed out at the end of the week, due in the following Thursday.

Science: In Science we will be learning about 'Animals and their offspring.

We look at the differences between mammals, amphibians, reptiles, birds and insects.

Computina:

The children will be following the Purple Mash scheme of work. They can also access Purple Mash at home using the format: Initial and surname (i.e. HBowcock) password: pink.

PSHE: During this first half term, we will be looking at Citizenship followed by Economic Wellbeing and Transition.

Maths: This term we will be continuing our work on Fractions followed by Time, Statistics and Position and

Direction. Our investigations will follow concrete, pictorial and abstract methods. As always, we are continuously working on our 2, 5 and 10 times tables to ensure these are embedded by the end of Year 2.

Art: We will be developing colour mixing skills, learning about the work of artist Romare Bearden and creating textured papers using paint, children compose collages inspired by their exploration of colour and texture in the world around them.

D&T:

In our D and T lessons we will be looking at food hygiene, tasting bread and creating our own bread. Making sandwiches and vegetable stew. We will be learning the skills of cutting, chopping, grating food safely. We will taste the food that we have made.

Music: We will be listening and responding to music using the Charanga music programme, as well as performing our own pieces and using improvisation skills. 🏶 PE: Our PE day is a Tuesday. This term we will be working

on athletics - developing our stamina and strength as we learn how to run, jump and throw using the correct techniques. We will also be learning how to play Rounders and working on batting and bowling skills.
