

## How we Performed in 2017:-

**Key Stage 2 results** - all test scores have been converted into "scaled scores" from 80 to 120 with 100 the expected standard for each subject (Reading, Grammar punctuation and spelling and Maths) except Writing and science -which are teacher assessed.

### Key stage 2 results - children achieving 100 scaled score or above.

In 2016 the DfE have said that the KS2 SATs are NOT comparable to other years but they have developed a progress check to allow schools to show progress from KS1 to 2. This will be available in September. **Progress KS1 to KS2** - (The progress score is shown as a negative or positive score for the whole school where 0 would be the "average" progress).

### Phonics Check

2 pupils did not achieve the expected score in phonics test last year 2016 50% achieved it this year. Plus two other children joined the class from Wales and France both children achieved this year 100%. So the overall score for the phonics in year 2 is 75%.

**Phonics results in Year 1** - 5 children did not achieve the standard and 1 child was absent 24/ 30 children achieved the standard = **80%**. PP 3/4 children achieved the standard=75%, Boys 8/11=73%, Girls= 17/19= 89.5%.
