Texts

- ◆ Non-fiction- 'In My Heart' - A book about feelings. Learning how there is a normal range of feelings that all humans experience.
- ◆ Fiction- 'The Marvellous Fluffy Itty Bitty'

PE:

GEOGRAPHY: We will name and locate the seven continents and the five oceans of the world.


We will study the human and physical geography of a small area in the UK and compare this with Mexico.

We will study a mini topic on Iceland. We will look at the key physical man features of that country.


SCIENCE: Through our Science topic on plants we will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

CHALLENGE
