Please see the arrangements below for reporting positive cases to school during the start of the summer holidays.

For any children that are awaiting tests results after the close of school on Friday, we respectfully ask that when these results are available they are emailed to [testresults@st-annes-browndedge.staffs.sch.uk](mailto:testresults@st-annes-browndedge.staffs.sch.uk) After 12pm on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July, school SHOULD NOT be contacted and this email will not be monitored.

For your ease, a simplified flow diagram is included below.

**SCHOOL CLOSES ON FRIDAY 16<sup>th</sup> JULY AT 6:00pm**

If your child shows any symptoms or tests positive within 48 hours of school closing up to 6:00pm on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2021. (N.B. This is extended to 12pm on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July for Y6 only) please contact the school by email to say that your child is symptomatic / positive. Please state your child's name and whether you are getting your child tested. School email address to be used is [testresults@st-annes-browndedge.staffs.sch.uk](mailto:testresults@st-annes-browndedge.staffs.sch.uk)

If your child shows any symptoms after 48 hours of school closing, after 6.00pm on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 (12pm 19.7.21 Y6 only) school **does not** need to be contacted. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

When you get your result you must email school to say whether it is positive or negative.

If the result is positive, school will contact all children and staff in the appropriate bubble and anyone who may have been in close contact.

**Public health will also be notified.**
