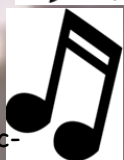


**ART:** In art, children will be designing invites using digital media, incorporated with our "Big Feast". We will use tie dye to build layers of colour and paint to combine colour, tints and tones.

**D&T:** In DT we will be cooking according to the Big Feast!". Children will look at nutrition and healthy foods before preparing a meal. We will use stitching to make a cushion for the Jubilee.

**MUSIC:** We will learn to find and keep a steady beat and copy back melodic patterns, talk about the words of a song, thinking about why it was written as well as learning to recognise different musical styles. We will also rehearse and learn songs from memory.

**MFL:** In our French town topic we will look at names of places, directional language, rooms in the house and descriptions of these rooms as well as household items. We will also do 3 weeks of conversational Spanish.



**HISTORY:**

We will be looking at the Royal Jubilee celebrations and examining the Queen's part in history across the Commonwealth. We will look at the history of the Commonwealth linked to the Commonwealth Games and changes that have occurred over time.

**GEOGRAPHY:**

We will look at 6 figure grid references, finding the Commonwealth countries on the map. We will use a range of maps to compare countries. For countries week we chose Spain, so we will particularly examine the landscape including landmarks.

**SCIENCE:**

We will look at the Human body and how it works. This will include the main parts of the human circulatory system, describing the function of heart, blood vessels, blood and other internal organs. We will recognise the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the human body. We will study how nutrients and water are transported in animals

We will be revisiting all areas of calculation and making links to our news topic where possible. We will be using maths skills to plan our own theme park and planning a holiday to Spain.

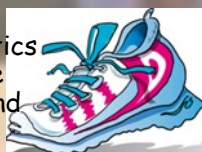
