

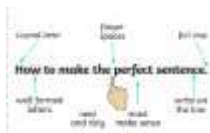


Literacy

This half term we will be looking at the Traditional Tales. We will be looking at the following texts:



We will be continuing to use Drawing club to support our writing. We will be writing about different characters, a different setting and an adventure that the characters are going on. We will be focussing on sentence structure to write our sentences.



Understanding the World: The Natural World

We will be looking for signs of Spring.

We will also be looking at what plants need to grow. We will be growing our own beanstalks and looking at how we should look after them.



Maths:

Length: We have been looking at tallest, shortest and we have been measuring using cubes.

Time: We will be looking at day and night. The days of the week. What a clock does. We have also been looking at sequencing how to make different objects.

9 and 10: The children will be able to sort out cards and match them to number 9 or 10. They will be also able to represent 9 and 10. The children will also be able to subitise and talk about how many there are on a dot plate.

One more and One less: The children will be looking at finding one more and one less from a number.



Understanding the World: People, Culture and Communities

PHSE:

Expressive Arts and Design:
