RE : RECEPTION BALANCE BIKE CLUB

Your child has expressed an interest in joining the St Anne's Balance Bike Club. The club will run on Thursdays after school commencing Thursday, 28th April.

The sessions will take place immediately after school until 4:00 p.m. on St Anne's playground. Children should be collected from their normal door at the end of each session. Children will need to ensure that they have suitable footwear in school. The balance bikes and cycle helmets will be supplied by school.

The course that the children will be taking part in is Ready, Set, Ride programme in association with HSBC. Children will be taking part in off-bike games to get them ready for riding and then taking part in activities to build up skills on balance bikes ready for them to be pedalling independently.

We are expecting a high-uptake on this club and unfortunately only 8 children can take part in the club at any one time. Therefore, it may be necessary to structure two sessions over the rest of the term e.g. Group A - a four week course followed by Group B - a four week course. It may also be necessary to randomly select children by draw if numbers are particularly high.
