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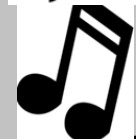
We will be focusing on drawing this term. In the first half of the term we will be learning about line, observation and movement using multimedia to experiment and create.

D&T

This term we will learn about health and safety and safely preparing food. The children will each learn to safely cut and prepare food. We will also create a product that has a lever, the children will use the lever to make the car move along the road.

MUSIC:

We will sing songs about Ourselves and our bodies. We will follow the Charanga scheme, listen to the beat & pulse. The children are already brilliant at using the boomwackers and we will continue to use these in year one. We will also use the glockenspiels to play songs and to improvise.



GEOGRAPHY: (Geography focus this half term)

We will talk about where we live & look further afield to the UK and the 7 continents. We will find some facts about our local area. We will look at the months of the year, the seasons and changes in weather.

SCIENCE:

-We will explore humans & name the main parts of the human body and link them to their 5 senses.

-We will use our senses to compare different textures, sounds and smells.

-We will draw and label the parts of the human body that they can see.

HISTORY

-We will learn about the changes that happen over time. Focusing on the changes to the history of our school.



PE:

Outdoors - ball skills

We will be moving fluently, changing direction and avoiding collisions whilst developing our control of the ball. We will practise our throwing, catching, dribbling and kicking skills. We will be shooting at a target and developing our co-ordination.

After half term we will focus on Indoor Games.

MATHS:

At the beginning of the Autumn term we will focus on telling the time to half past and o'clock. We will then become secure with counting to 20 forwards and backwards. We will work with numbers 0-10 this will include one more and one less, number words, sorting, counting backwards, positional language, comparing and addition and subtraction. We will be adding and subtracting using a variety of methods including part whole modes, number bonds and number lines.
