

ART: In art, we will be working in the style of Van Gogh, painting "Field of Poppies" using colour combinations to tone and shade. Use techniques to show shadows and reflections.



D&T: We are making wartime food, taking into account rationing measuring and calculating ratios.



MUSIC:

We will be looking at music used for celebrations and where the origins of these songs come from historically. We will play and perform different types of music and be able to talk about the effects that this has on people.



HISTORY: In Year 6 we will be looking into the war, experiencing evacuation, learning about how World War Two began, the roles of men and women. We will research the Blitz and examine blackouts. We will also look at WW1 at the appropriate time. We will explore propaganda, timelines and dates and explore chronology.

GEOGRAPHY: We will look at the locations of the countries involved in the war and using map skills and grid references to explain countries involved in the war.

SCIENCE:

Year 6 will be looking at light, how shadows are made and what refraction and reflection are.



PE:

In PE we will be learning hockey skills through attacking and defending followed by indoor athletics to include standing long jump, triple jump and throwing.

ENTRY POINT

Launch day will involve making air raid shelters in the woods, learning about different types of air raid shelters. We will make gas mask boxes and then model air raid shelters using shoe boxes. Children and staff will dress in typical dress of the time.

RE

We will be learning about Creation and the big question of how this can be compared to Evolution. We will learn how to find texts in the Bible and how that science and Christianity go together.

PSHE

Children will start by learning about me and my school and discussing democracy and rules.



CHALLENGE

Regular air raid sirens and use air raid shelter in the classroom.
Wartime reporting regularly.

ENGLISH:

We will be reading Letters from the Lighthouse and The Journey. We will examine, write and perform war Poetry related to World War One. Where possible we will use drama to enhance the children's experience of the war. We will be extending our writing style and using different texts to work on our comprehension skills. Spellings will be weekly booklets using statutory words.

MATHS:

In Maths we will be exploring place value and using numbers up to the 10,000,000 as well as exploring integers and negative numbers. We will also look at different ways of approaching the four calculations and when to choose each method.

COMPUTING:

We will be code-breaking in order to show the children the importance of security in the war as well as using our research skills.
