

ART:

We will be using pencil, crayon, felt tip, wax and chalk to practice drawing with control. We will draw from images and create still life drawings. Whilst practicing control we will also work on drawing within the lines.

D&T:

This term the children will design a space ship and then create it using a range of materials and tools.

MUSIC:

We will be using our imagination and using music to see where our imagination takes us.

-We will be using music from Joanna Mangona and Pete Readman.

-We will be continuing our work using the glockenspiels.

-We will be finding the pulse and rhythm in different pieces.



GEOGRAPHY: We will use the correct geographical vocabulary to refer to human and physical features. We will begin to look at the characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding Seas. We will continue to use a variety of resources including maps, atlases and globes.

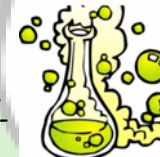


History

We will use our trip to Manchester Airport to support learning about the history of vehicles. We will compare how we travel now to how we travel in the past. We will learn about the Wright Brothers and the invention of the first airplane.

SCIENCE

This term we will be learning about Animals including Humans. We will be comparing the structure of different animals bodies. We will also describe the differences between a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals including pets.



ENGLISH:

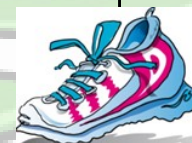
This term we are looking at the poem When I am By My Self. We will be looking at rhyming pairs, matching images to words that rhyme. The children will learn how to keep rhythm within their writing.

After learning to write poetry and creating their own poem, the children will read The Way Back Home by Oliver Jeffers.

This is a narrative text, we will focus on adjectives, nouns, verbs and adverbs. The children will then continue the plot by writing about the Boy and Martian visiting another planet.

RE

Within our RE lessons we will be looking at 'What is the good news Jesus brings?'

MATHS:

This term we will be learning about multiplication and division- solving one-step problems using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays (2's,5's,10's). We will also begin to use the multiplication and division symbols and reading number sentences.

We will learn about the value of coins and notes. Learning how to recognise and use them by adding, taking away and buying holidays from our Year 1 travel agents!

During our Jubilee celebration week we will also begin to learn how to tell the time. We will learn how to tell the time to the hour and half past the hour.

COMPUTING:

This term in computing we will be learning how to code. The children will learn how to give and follow instructions. They will be using purple mash to arrange code blocks, create simple programmes and understand programmes before using code to create a programme they have designed.
