

ENGLISH: for our final term in Y2 we will be continuing to base much of our work around focus texts. From these books we will write a variety of stories, poems, diary entries, instructions and recounts. We will also continue to work on our punctuation and grammar, spellings and handwriting.

Texts

- ◆ Poetry -'If I were in charge of the world'- Where we will be going on a poetry journey. Introducing the shapes of poems and writing our own poems.
- ◆ Fiction—Little Red Reading Hood— a story based on the classic tale of Little Red Riding Hood but with a reading twist!
- ◆ Non-fiction- 'In My Heart' - A book about feelings. Learning how there is a normal range of feelings that all humans experience.
- ◆ Fiction- 'The Marvellous Fluffy Itty Bitty'

PE: In our PE lessons this term, we will be doing athletics, looking at the correct ways to take off and land. We will also be learning how to master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching. Our annual sports day will take place in June and we will develop our multi-skills activities leading up to this.



RE- Through our Christianity Topic we will be looking 'What is the good news that Jesus brings? Looking at how Christians show their beliefs: for example thanking God in prayer.

Through our Judaism Topic we will be looking at the religion of Judaism. Looking at what Jews believe and how it affects the way they live their lives.

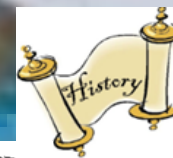


PSHE
