Therefore, I am writing to inform you of the election arrangements should you wish to stand for the Parent Governor post. Parent Governors are appointed for a four-year period irrespective of whether their children remain in school during that period.

PROCEDURES FOR NOMINATION AND VOTING:

Parents who wish to stand as a candidate for election should complete the nomination form at the end of this letter. The nomination form then needs to be signed by the candidate and two other parents. Parents of all children currently registered at the school are entitled to stand for election or to nominate others. For these purposes "parent" includes a step-parent, guardian or other persons having care of the child or having parental responsibility. **Please note that Parent Governors may be grandparents or may have had children previously at St. Anne's C.E. Primary School.**

The role of School Governor has changed significantly over the past few years and the demands placed on Governors have dramatically increased. Therefore, any nominated candidate must be prepared to attend meetings at school, usually 2 meetings a term. These are usually held early evening on Mondays either online via TEAMS or in person. Governors are also required to attend training sessions. In addition, Governors are also involved in the day-to-day work of the school and may on occasions work in school with staff and children. There is a commitment on attending Link Governor work during the school day once a term.

If anyone who is considering standing would like more information about the role, then please do not hesitate in speaking to any member of the Governing Body about what they do or make an appointment to have an informal chat with Mr. Hobson.

Following a Governor Skills Audit we are particularly looking for Governors with a skill set that might include a background in one or more of the following: IT, Human Resources, Finance, Law or Health. **Please note that these skills are not essential and are only desirable.** All candidates who are nominated will go into the ballot.

A completed nomination form must be returned to the school no later than Friday, 19th June at 3.00 p.m. It would be helpful if candidates would submit a brief statement about themselves. This will be distributed to all parents to help them to make their decision when voting.

As soon as possible following the closing date for nominations all parents will be sent a ballot paper giving details of each of the candidates. Parents will be asked to indicate their




preference as appropriate and return the ballot paper to the school office no later than the date shown. To comply with statutory regulations, the ballot will be conducted in secret.
