



Reading:

In reading this term we will be reading Final Year for our enjoyable read as well as running Book Club once a week. In Book Club, we will be recommending different texts to each other that we have enjoyed and doing belly book bands. In guided reading we will be examining comprehension questions and learning how to evidence.



Writing:

In writing this term we will be using a honing our persuasive writing skills by creating travel brochures, writing from different perspectives to different audiences and ensuring that we improve our punctuation in cross-curricular writing.



Science:

Variation and Adaptations

Looking at how species have evolved over time. How species adapt to their environment. We will also look at Darwin's work and the concept of Inheritance in biology.

Fossils

What are fossils? How are they formed. We will also look at sediment.



Computing:

We will be looking at how to blog, looking at how to understand binary and also using text to make creative effects.



Maths:

We've done some great work consolidating and building on previous learning during Autumn & Spring Term. We've spent a long time reinforcing the arithmetic skills. And developing reasoning skills. We will develop reasoning and arithmetic. Then look at preparing for Y7 including using calculators.

Number and place value: Recognition of whole numbers up to 6 digits including decimals. Comparing positive and negative integers. Missing number questions. Recognising odd/even/square/triangular and prime numbers. We will also introduce Algebra, using formulae.

Calculations: Using four rules of number. Alongside calculating with fractions including fractions where denominators are different.

Fractions, Decimals and Percentages: equivalent fractions, changing fractions and decimals into percentages. Finding percentages of a number.

Measurement: Convert between g/kg, mm/cm/m/km. compare metric and imperial units. Also, finding volume, area and perimeter.



RE: How do people of God find justice and Peace?

Looking at how the story of Moses and his quest for freedom for Gods people including looking at the 10 Commandments. We will also look at the Jewish faith.

PHSE:

In PHSE we will be examining me and my relationships as an aid to transition, thinking about the building of friendships and how relationships can change. We will also look at our place in the world and how we can impact the world around us.



History:

We will be examining how crime and punishment has changed over time. They have examined types of punishment and how criminals were treated over time. We will learn about this from Victorian times until present day.



Geography:
