As a group we walked around the School premises and would comment as follows:-

- The pallet gate near the green shed on the Junior Playground was in need of attention - scruffy- **WILL TO ADDRESS**
- The Storage Box in the quiet area was broken. It was just stuffed full of rubbish and needed sorting and perhaps monitors attached to it to ensure it stayed tidy and things were not just dumped in it **WILL TO SORT OUT**
- There were always leaves and rubbish in the quiet area and was not very pleasant to use **WILL TO KEEP ON TOP OF**

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- The bins generally on the playgrounds were often not emptied **WILL TO EMPTY REGULARLY**
- The pigeon spikes on the Junior Playground equipment needed replacing - **DR explained WH was in the process of replacing them and this would be done as soon as possible**
- The volley ball nets need replacing **This is a monetary issue but EH feel these have not been looked after well.**
- Various trees/bushes round the whole of the school needed to be trimmed/tied. **DR explained the Croppers were due w/c: 18.11.2025**
- The outdoor classroom was very messy and uninviting. It was also dirty and needed a good tidy. They asked if there was a solution to all the wellies just being chucked in there? The bin by the side of the outdoor classroom was full **Mrs Bailey to address**
- They asked for one piece of the apparatus in the outside gym to be mended. I think Mr. Hobson may have sorted this previously? **Mr Hobson unaware of this and thought it was fixed. Will investigate.**
- There were large bags of leaves stored on the way up to Forest School - these needed moving. **WH said he would sort**
- The clock sign on the Junior Playground no longer had hands on it - could this be taken down or the hands replaced **Will to take down if cannot fix**
- Many of the signs on the walls on the Infant Playground were broken/faded - could these be replaced? **Will please take down and we will look to replace**
- Some concern about the gate in to Reception new outside area no being brilliant **Will manages as and when**
- Looking from the playground up to the whole of the Reception outside play areas, both top and bottom, these were often full of leaves, rubbish etc. **Could WH ensure that these were always brushed and tidy because children were aware how much the Reception children used this area and it should always be free from stuff**

Everything looked ok

## Old Staff Room

- Looked like things were just dumped in there. It was cold for music lessons and sometimes was not very inviting. **Staff asked to manage by Mr Hobson**

## New Staff Room

- Wires hanging from the server cupboard - could be a H&S issue **Mr Hobson to address**

## Infant Toilets

- Some of the taps in the boys toilets dripped - **could WH look at these please**
- **Maybe clean the plastic steps in both toilets are they looked grimy and dirty DR to ask Jackie**

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## Year 1

- Quite a few cracked ceiling tiles Nothing can necessarily be done here. **Will to check for spare ones.**
- Y1 outside area was the same. Full of leaves etc. and should be checked on a daily basis to ensure it was always inviting to the Y1 children **Will to address**

## Reception

- The carpet was a real mess and the carpet strip between the hard floor and carpet was dangerous and children asked for this to be pulled up immediately
- The black gaffer tape which was hiding holes etc. needed replacing **Will to replace**
- From the outside area children could see that some of the pigeon spikes on the Infant play equipment also needed replacing **Will addressing**

## Year 5

- The carpet is horrible **This is a monetary issue and EH would love to replace**
- Some of the ceiling tiles need replacing **Will to check for spare ones**
- There were blocks on top of the screen - H&S concerns **EH to address**

## Year 6

- Could WH please look at replacing the cold water tap at the sink as this was constantly dripping? **Will to address**
- The blinds in Y6 needed to be looked at/repared **Will to negotiate with Alexa and take down**
- There were several cracks in the store room **EH to address with county**

## Library

- Could Will look at the House Stickers on the left-hand side as you walk in to the library as these needed re-gluing before they were totally ripped in particular **Water Will to address**

## Year 3

- No major concerns other than there were quite a few open wires around the classroom from notebooks not being plugged in

- Nothing major - cracks in ceiling

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## Corridors

- Can the pictures be updated with current children? EH to look into
- The two boxes near the Gents Toilet seem to be wasted - can there be a use for them?

- Looked tired

## Hall

- The hall floor looks tired and scruffy This is a monetary issue and EH would love to replace
- The paper aeroplanes that were stuck in the lights needed to come down as this was a fire hazard Will to remove
- They found boxes of matches in the hall - again fire hazard
- The tassels near the altar/candle - some of them again were concerned that the tassels were a fire hazard
- They actually pulled out the book cases in the hall and retrieved so much stuff including rubbish/food.
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## Junior Toilets

- The pipework/radiators in both toilets were grotty and rusty Will to cover with lagging
